



## 2013-14 ECYEH Counts by Region, County, and State

The following table shows the total served population (24,504) of children and youth identified as experiencing homelessness. The definition of served includes children experiencing homelessness who have been served in any way through McKinney-Vento funds.

Unique count is where a student is identified as homeless AND attributed either because their Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) was attributed to this LEA or they were enrolled the longest in this LEA. The unique count is used for SEA reporting in EDFacts.

Duplicate count is where a student is identified as homeless. They may be identified in more than one LEA. The duplicated count is used for LEA reporting in EDFacts.
