RE Uniform Crime Reporting Act (Act 180 of 2004)

MESSAGE:

In accordance with the "Uniform Crime Reporting Act" and the "College and University Security Regulations," each institution of higher education is required to annually file, on or before March 1, an assurance statement regarding the institution's compliance with the act and the regulations. Although the legislation does not specifically include for-profit institutions, the Department is requesting that degree-granting, for-profit institutions also complete the assurance form.

The assurance form, legislation and regulations are available on the PDE website: [Uniform Crime Reporting Act](#). Please note that an assurance form must be completed for the main campus, as well as each branch campus. The form(s) shall be signed by the president of each institution of higher education or the president's designee.
