Why is the follow-up survey needed?

- Meet federal accountability requirements
- Increase student survey response rates
- Enhance available data needed for CTE program evaluation and improvement efforts

Postsecondary 2016 CTE Follow-Up Survey

Which postsecondary students are included in the survey?

Per Perkins requirements, states need to identify CTE concentrators who left postsecondary education during the 2014-15 reporting year.

Therefore, in school year 2014-15, CTE postsecondary students who should be reported in PIMS should have:

(1) at least 12 cumulative, combined academic and occupational CTE program credits;

AND

(2) a program “end date” which indicates the student exited or completed the postsecondary Perkins program during the academic year.

Postsecondary 2016 CTE Follow-Up Survey

How can postsecondary institutions identify the specific students that should complete the follow-up survey questions?

PIMS Reports (COGNOS) will allow postsecondary institutions to generate the following information submitted for the survey students:

- PAsecureID
- Institution ID (LEA Administrative Unit Number/9-digit AUN)
- Institution Name
- Campus ID (4-digit campus code)
- Campus Name
- Last Name
- First Name
- Street Address 1
- Additional Street Address 2

Postsecondary 2016 CTE Follow-Up Survey

How can postsecondary institutions identify the specific students that should complete the follow-up survey questions?

PIMS Reports (COGNOS) will allow postsecondary institutions to generate the following information submitted for the survey questions (continued):

- City
- State
- ZIP Code
- ZIP Code Extension
- CIP Code
- CIP Title
- Security Code – needed for student to log into web survey.
- School Year
- Start Date
- End Date
- Survey Submitted

How can postsecondary institutions notify students to complete the web-based survey?

- Mail
- Email
- Phone
- Any combination of above

What if students do not have direct access to the internet?


- Student may access internet via library or school
- With the student's permission (written or verbal), postsecondary institutions may enter the student's survey response data

- June 8 - Postsecondary institutions complete “second wave” of student communications
- July 20 - Postsecondary institutions complete “third wave” of student communications
- August 31 - PDE closes follow-up web survey application
