This program includes instruction in the care and guidance of children; care of the aged, handicapped or convalescent; nutrition and meal planning; marketing and food preparation and service; grooming and dressing; care and laundering of clothing and household linens; managing and performing household tasks; cleaning and caring for home furnishings and household equipment; practice of safety measures and sanitation; answering correspondence and paying bills; organizing outings for exercise or social activities; reading and playing games; and community services available. Programs prepare individuals to perform other related duties to promote wellness and independent living or to work in institutions providing similar care.
