<p>Provide Guidance & Support to Individual Teachers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Custom Student Report ▪ Teacher Diagnostic Report 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ What is the teacher's history of growth with students in the lowest third, middle third, and highest third achievement groups? ▪ What are the risk levels of the current students in a teacher's classroom/section (e.g., who are those students at a minimum level of risk, moderate level of risk, and high level of risk)? ▪ What is the balance in the classroom/section of students of high, moderate, and low risk levels in order to support this teacher with differentiated instruction within the classroom?
