

Ed-Flex Waivers Approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education

Pennsylvania's Department of Education has been granted the authority to waive two sections of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) by the United States Department of Education (USDE.) ESEA (section 1113(a)(2)(B)) waiver allows schools to qualify for Title I, Part A funds within a district that otherwise would not be eligible. ESEA (section 1114(a)(1)) waiver allows schools to operate a schoolwide program with a lower poverty rate between 30 and 40 percent, provided the building has an approved schoolwide plan in place.
