



Summary of the Disclosure of Interscholastic Athletic Opportunities – 2012-13 School Year

On June 30, 2012, Governor Corbett signed into law Act 82 (24 P.S. § 16-1601-C) which includes a provision entitled the Disclosure of Interscholastic Athletics Opportunities Act (Act). This Act directs each public school in Pennsylvania, which offers interscholastic athletic opportunities, to post on its website, and all other forms of communication for the residents of their district, a disclosure form, which details the number of male and female participants on each of the school's varsity, junior varsity, freshman, eighth and seventh grade athletic team. The completed form for each school entity is also required to be posted by PDE on its website and submitted to the General Assembly by January 15 of each year.

The Act requires that all public local education agencies (LEA) (public school districts, brick-and-mortar charter schools, cyber charter schools, and full-time comprehensive technical centers) complete and submit the PDE-created disclosure form by October 15 of each year. LEAs are required to report athletic participation, staffing, revenues and expenses for each of their male and female teams. The disclosure form requires the school entities to disclose on the form, among other things, the following statistical information relating to students:

- Total number of students in the school:
 - Listed by gender:
 - Male athletes
 - Female athletes
- Listing by gender each varsity, junior varsity, freshman, eighth and seventh grade athletic teams, as well as:
 - The total number of team members
 - The total number of male participants
 - The total number of female participants

Other provisions of the law require the school entities to make detailed disclosures concerning expenditures made on behalf of individual teams, staffing levels and the number of competitions scheduled and played.
