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

The federal regulations require a state match [Maintenance of Effort Requirement (1977). Specifically, the regulations state that expenditures from state sources in any fiscal year for the administration of the National School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, the Special Milk Program, and the Child and Adult Care Food Program shall not be less than that expended or obligated in fiscal year 1977 (\$35,221).


