The U.S. Department of Agriculture provides these funds to the Pennsylvania Department of Education for the administration of child nutrition programs, including the National School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, the Special Milk Program, the After School Snack Program, the Child and Adult Food Care Program, the At-Risk Snack Program, the Summer Food Service Program, and the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program. The federal regulations require a state match [Maintenance of Effort Requirement (1977).] Specifically, the regulations state that expenditures from state sources in any fiscal year for the administration of the National School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, the Special Milk Program, and the Child and Adult Care Food Program shall not be less than that expended or obligated in fiscal year 1977 (\$35,221).

The Title I School Improvement Grant (SIG) provides states with funding that must go directly to Title I schools identified for school improvement. These funds are directed to Local Education Agencies and must be used to assist them in meeting the state's annual achievement targets on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment. The SIG program was funded by fiscal year grant awards from 2009 through 2016. The grants for fiscal years 2013 through 2016 each received five-year extensions from the United States Department of Education. At this point, the only funds that remain are from the fiscal year 2016-17 grant, which must be liquidated by September 30, 2022. There will be no need for spending authority after that date, as the Pennsylvania Department of Education has closed out all projects and liquidated all funds from the previous year grant awards. The SIG program was discontinued with the advent of the Every Student Succeeds Act, which, beginning in fiscal year 2017, called for an increase in the School Improvement set aside amount of the Commonwealth's regular Title I allocation from four percent to seven percent. This increase essentially replaced the dedicated school improvement funding that was eliminated with the discontinuation of the SIG program, and was intentionally written into the law for this purpose..
