Significant Accounting Policies

Management has the responsibility to select and use appropriate accounting policies. A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the School is included in Note 2 to the financial statements. There have been no initial selection of accounting policies and no changes in significant accounting policies or their application during fiscal year 2020. No matters have come to our attention that would require us, under professional standards, to inform you about (1) the methods used to account for significant unusual transactions and (2) the effect of significant accounting policies in controversial or emerging areas for which there is a lack of authoritative guidance or consensus. Significant Accounting Estimates Accounting estimates are an integral part of the financial statements prepared by management and are based on management's knowledge and experience about past and current events and assumptions about future events. Certain accounting estimates are particularly sensitive because of their significance to the financial statements and because of the possibility that future events affecting them may differ significantly from those expected. The most sensitive estimates affecting the financial statements were the accumulated depreciation, functional allocation of expenses, and allowance for doubtful accounts. Management's estimate of depreciation expense and the related accumulated depreciation is based on the straight-line method of depreciation over the estimated useful lives of the assets. Management's estimate of the functional allocation of expenses is based on an analysis of the activity in the expense accounts. Management's estimate of the allowance for uncollectible accounts is based on management's evaluation of the outstanding receivables. Significant Difficulties Encountered During the Audit We encountered no significant difficulties in dealing with management in performing and completing our audit. Uncorrected and Corrected Misstatements As part of our audit, we assisted management with the preparation of the year-end adjustments. The attached schedule summarizes the adjustments we assisted management with. Management has posted these adjustments, and they are reflected in the financial statements of the School. For purposes of this communication, professional standards require us to accumulate all known and likely misstatements identified during the audit, other than those that we believe are trivial, and communicate them to the appropriate level of management. Findings. or Issues In the normal course of our professional association with the School, we generally discuss a variety of matters, including the application of accounting principles and auditing standards, operating conditions affecting the entity, and operating plans and strategies that may affect the risks of material misstatement. None of the matters discussed resulted in a condition to our retention as the School's auditor.
