Enclosed is the Report of Findings presenting results of the Chapter 16 monitoring which was conducted by the Bureau of Special Education (BSE) in the School District the week of December 2, 2019.

The Executive Summary is arranged in two parts and includes an Appendix. PART I presents the Summary of Findings including an explanation of the review process and general findings. PART II describes the corrective action process. A description identifying findings of noncompliance, corrective action required, and results of interviews of staff and parents can be found in the Appendix.
