EXPORTING PROFESSIONAL DATA IN TIMS

Program providers can export a data file that will provide information on where their graduates are working. The Export Professional Data feature in TIMS displays PIMS "Assignment Location" and "Institution Name" for the most recent PIMS School Year that has been verified and closed. Currently that is the 2013-2014 school year; soon TIMS will display the 2014-2015 school year.

For detailed instructions see the attached document. We will provide training on the "Export" feature at the PACTE conference on October 25, 2015 and in webinars later in the fall for those who cannot attend the conference.

- Single occupancy is at the attendee's own cost of \$143.19 per night; single occupancy registrants are responsible for making their own reservations.
