# STUDENT DEFINITIONS

## A. Secondary Level

# Participant -

A student, who by the end of the reporting school year, was reported as having earned at least 10% of the minimum technical instructional hours required for Pennsylvania Department of Education program approval.

# **Concentrator** –

A student, who by the end of the reporting school year, was reported as having earned at least 50% of the minimum technical instructional hours required for Pennsylvania Department of Education program approval.

# **B.** Postsecondary Level

# Participant -

A postsecondary student, who by the end of the reporting school year, was reported as having earned more than one (1) academic or CTE credits required by an approved occupational program.

#### **Concentrator** –

A postsecondary student, who by the end of the reporting school year, was reported as having been enrolled in an approved occupational program and completed at least 12 academic or CTE credits within a single program area sequence that is comprised of 12 or more academic and technical credits and terminates in the award of an industry-recognized credential, a certificate, or a degree.
