The U.S. Department of Agriculture provides these funds to the Pennsylvania Department of Education for the administration of child nutrition programs, including the National School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, the Special Milk Program, the After School Snack Program, the Child and Adult Food Care Program, the At-Risk Snack Program, the Summer Food Service Program, and the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program. The federal regulations require a state match [Maintenance of Effort Requirement (1977)]. Specifically, the regulations state that expenditures from state sources in any fiscal year for the administration of the National School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, the Special Milk Program, and the Child and Adult Care Food Program shall not be less than that expended or obligated in fiscal year 1977 (\$35,221).
